

ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS)

MEMORANDUM FROM THE CHAIRPERSON (DATED JUNE 13, 2017)

- Lifelong learners who graduated from High School in the old curriculum are still eligible to enter college by SY 2018-2019
- HEIs are encouraged to accommodate LLL through the following means:
 - Extension of deadline of application/enrollment
 - Offer programs that address the needs of LLL (ex. Ladderized programs, distance education, ETEEAP, etc.)
 - Offer programs preferred by LLL and identified by regional priorities and industry roadmaps
 - Direct poor and deserving students to scholarships of CHED (StuFAPs, Tulong Dunong) and UNIFAST (Free Tuition and other fees (for SUCs, TES,)



ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS)

CMO NO. 10, S. 2018 – POLICY OF ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM COMPLETERS AND PASSERS OF THE A& E TEST IN RELATION TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

- Subject to admission policies and requirements and submission of Certificate of Rating issued by DepEd
 - passers of previous A & E Tests HS Level including November 2017, March 2018 and 2019 tests



SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- CMO No. 105, s. 2017 Policy on the Admission of Senior High School Graduates to the Higher Education Institutions effective AY 2018-2019
 - All Grade 12 graduates beginning AY 2017-2018 are eligible to enter college regardless of the track or strand take in SHS
 - No Grade 12 student or graduate shall be denied acceptance in applying for college entrance examination in HEIs

Enrollment is subject to admission requirements of the admitting HEI

TO INCREASE ACCESS TO QUALITY HIGHER EDUCATION

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Republic Act 10931 - "Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act"

- signed on August 3, 2017
- to promote Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education by SUCs, LUCs and State-Run Technical-Vocational Institutions effective Academic Year 2018-2019.

The Unified Financial Assistance System for Tertiary Education Act, or UniFAST — also known as Republic Act No. 10687

To reconcile, improve, strengthen, expand, and put under one body all government-funded modalities of Student Financial Assistance Programs (StuFAPs) for tertiary education – and special purpose education assistance – in both public and private institutions

Programs: Tertiary Education Subsidy, Study Now Pay Later Plan, Tulong Dunong and Other Grants-in Aid Programs

TO INCREASE ACCESS TO QUALITY HIGHER EDU

CHED Memorandum No. 54, s. 2016 - Expanded Tertiary Education Equivalency And Accreditation Program (ETEEAP)

- a comprehensive educational assessment program at the tertiary level that recognizes, accredits and gives equivalencies to knowledge, skills, attitudes and values gained by individuals from relevant work.
- implemented through deputized HEIs that shall award the appropriate college degree.

 - Only complete documents per checklist will be received to comply with RA on Ease of Doing Business
- Computer-aided receiving of documents
- Strict implementation of Deadlines
- Implementation of SO system CHED-NCR Memo No. 39, s. 2018

NEW PROCESSES/PROCEDURES

For SO Application

- 1. Fully accomplished routing slip for processing of S.O.
- 2. Letter of Recommendation for graduation duly signed by the Registrar and attested by the authority School Official (2 copies) with receiving copy.
- 3. Form IX of the students recommended for S.O.
- 4. Copy of approved curriculum checklist with evaluation signed by the Registrar (curriculum evaluation must reflect the credited subjects/courses if transferee)

- 5. other documents necessary if the processing of S.O. e.g. cross enrolment
- If late application of S.O. submit requirements stated in Memorandum dated April 20, 2008 (SY 2016-2017 below)
- If name is not included in the submitted enrolment list submit requirements stated in Memorandum dated April 12, 2008.
- Timely submission of Enrolment list (soft and Hard copy). Please submit Soft copy of E.L. to Mrs. Editha A. Paragas, ES II In-Charge of S.O. Do not submit application of S.O. without enrolment list submitted. Make sure that the name is included the enrolment list. Make sure all entries in the

application are correct to avoid delay of S.O.

For FOREIGN STUDENTS:

1. Please use the prescribed new format in reporting FS data effective SY 2019-2020.

For Record Purposes (MIS)

1. submit certified copy of the authority to accept FS.

2. submit certified copy of Program Accreditation - (PAASCU, etc.)
